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## Gallery-hopping and Food-tease

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And for those of you who like to go to galleries where you recognize the artist's name, DTR Modern Galleries (167 Newbury) is the place for you. Last week, DTR opened the largest surrealist exhibition in Boston. Works by Max Ernst, Rene Magritte, Joan Miro, Alexander Calder, and Salvador Dali line the walls of this bright and welcoming gallery floor. Homesick New Yorkers would be happy to know this is a Chelsea-based gallery which focuses entirely on 20th century art. DTR offered five complete suites of Dali and I was surprised to see that many had little red dots on them, the equivalent of the "I'm going home!" sign on puppy cages at pet stores. Note: if you want to take Dali's *The Blood of the Yin and Yang* back with you to Gropius, you'll be \$14,850 behind in your loans.
